When you are baking a cake, it is important that you enjoy the experience. Your kitchen should be bright and happy, and you must use all the best ingredients. You want the cake to come out looking great, so make sure that you start by greasing a 28 cm x 18 cm lamington tin, and line the base with greaseproof paper. If you are so inclined, you might want to gather all the ingredients together as it can be helpful to premeasure everything so that it is quick. Combine all ingredients in a small bowl of an electric mixer. Watch the ingredients all blend together. Beat at a low speed until blended, then beat at a high speed for 3 minutes. Make sure that you don't get your fingers caught in the beaters. Pour mixture into tin and bake in a moderate oven for 30-40 minutes. This is a good time to start cleaning up the mess, you might even enjoy licking the beaters!!! When cold ice with icing of choice and sprinkle with coconut or icing sugar.

"Cats is a musical composed by Andrew Lloyd Webber, based on Old Possum's Book of Practical Cats by T. S. Eliot, and produced by Cameron Mackintosh. The musical tells the story of a tribe of cats called the Jellies and the night they make what is known as "the Jellicoe choice" and decide which cat will ascend to the Heaviside Layer and come back to a new life. Cats introduced the song standard "Memory". The first performance of Cats was in 1981."

Andrew Lloyd Webber, Baron Lloyd-Webber [2][3] (born 22 March 1948) is an English composer and impresario of musical theatre.[4] Several of his musicals have run for more than a decade both in the West End and on Broadway. He has composed 13 musicals, a song cycle, a set of variations, two film scores, and a Latin Requiem Mass. Several of his songs have been widely recorded and were hits outside of their parent musicals, notably "The Music of the Night" from The Phantom of the Opera, "I Don't Know How to Love Him" from Jesus Christ Superstar, "Don't Cry for Me, Argentina" and "You Must Love Me" from Evita, "Any Dream Will Do" from Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat and "Memory" from Cats. In 2001 the New York Times referred to him as "the most commercially successful composer in history".[5] Ranked the "fifth most powerful person in British culture" by The Telegraph in 2008, the lyricist Don Black stated, "Andrew more or less single-handedly reinvented the musical."
